Q: When does the plastic bag ban go into effect? A: May 4, 2022

Q: Can shredded paper be placed in your recycling bin?

A: No, shredded paper from home can be thrown in regular trash or used for composting.

Once soiled, the paper cannot be recycled because the paper fibers will not be able to be separated from the oils during the pulping process.

A: #1 and #2 plastics. You can find the number in a triangle symbol located on bottom of plastic.

Q: True or False: This container is ready for recycling? (Dirty peanut butter jar) A: False – containers should be cleaned out, so they do not contaminate the recyclables.

Q: True or False: Plastic bags are not accepted in the recycling bin?

A: True, plastic bags do not go into the recycling bin. They clog the machinery at the recycling center which costs money to fix and lost time.

Q: True or False: Paper towels go into the recycling bin? A: No, they go into the regular trash.

Q: True or False: Recycling means changing old materials into new products? A: True. Glass, paper, plastic, and metals such as aluminum and steel are all commonly recycled. Q: True or False: 100,000 marine animals are killed each year as a result of plastic bag pollution?

A: True. This includes whales, dolphins, porpoises, seals and sea lions that ingest or get tangled in the plastic.

Q: On average, how long is a plastic bag used by a person before being thrown away? A: 12 minutes
